
Our Vision

Important Information

- Regular counsellors with no experience in this area can often make things worse.
- Be very careful who you tell as you may regret this later.
- Most people arrested for this offence have not committed a sexual contact offence.
- Porn addiction is a common pathway to CSAM. It is not a 1:1 ratio with paedophilia.


